

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise are the following in June 2024. **Priority 1: Road Safety** 

You said: That Road Safety issues are your number 1 concern.

What we are going to do: Targeted speeding enforcement operations and issuing Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) where appropriate.

### Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

You Said: Anti-Social Behaviour including use of motorbikes was an issue to you.

What we are going to do: Targeted patrols of hotspot locations as identified by local residents. If perpetrators are identified then appropriate action will be taken.

#### **Priority 3: Nuisance Motorbikes**

You Said: Nuisance Motorbikes was an issue to you:

What we are going to do: The beat team will be monitoring reports of nuisance motorbikes throughout the Fosse Villages. When reports are received we will carry out enquires to identify perpetrators and take appropriate actions to disrupt them.

## What we are doing

#### Priority 1: Road Safety:

- Due to operational commitments no speeding operation has taken place this month. One will be arranged in due course weather permitting. Please keep an eye out on social media as a speeding operation will be planned in the near future. Mays Farm Drive in Stoney Stanton has been highlighted as area concern. If there are any areas of concerns you want us to target please get in touch.


#### Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

- This month with the warmer weather there has been an increase in reports of anti-social behaviour which the beat team are monitoring. However there are no specific areas of concerns currently but residents are reminded to be respectful of others. If there are any concerns you want to raise please get in touch.

#### **Priority 3: Nuisance Motorbikes**

- As of 01/06/24 There have been multiple reports of the use of nuisance motorbikes in an anti-social manner the beat team are monitoring and conducting patrols of known hotspot areas.
