What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise are the following in July 2024. **Priority 1: Road Safety**

You said: That Road Safety issues are your number 1 concern.

What we are going to do: Targeted speeding enforcement operations and issuing Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) where appropriate.

Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

You Said: Anti-Social Behaviour including use of motorbikes was an issue to you.

What we are going to do: Targeted patrols of hotspot locations as identified by local residents. If perpetrators are identified then appropriate action will be taken.

Priority 3: Nuisance Motorbikes

You Said: Nuisance Motorbikes was an issue to you:

What we are going to do: The beat team will be monitoring reports of nuisance motorbikes throughout the Fosse Villages. When reports are received we will carry out enquires to identify perpetrators and take appropriate actions to disrupt them.

You said we did

Priority 1: Road Safety:

- The mobile speed enforcement camera visited Broughton Road, Croft as it is site of community concern as raised by local residents. I am pleased to say 0 offences were recorded over the time frame when the speed camera van was present.

Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

- This month with the warmer weather there has been an increase in reports of anti-social behaviour which the beat team are monitoring. There have been reports of issues at Stoney Cove with youths. If there are any concerns you want to raise please get in touch.

Priority 3: Nuisance Motorbikes

- As of 01/08/24 There have been multiple reports of the use of nuisance motorbikes in an anti-social manner the beat team are monitoring and conducting patrols of known hotspot areas. When suspects are identified they will be dealt with appropriately. Should you have any concerns please let your beat team know.
