## What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise are the following in September 2024.

### Priority 1: Road Safety

**You said:** That Road Safety issues are your number 1 concern.

**What we are going to do:** Targeted speeding enforcement operations and issuing Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) where appropriate.

### Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

**You Said:** Anti-Social Behaviour including use of motorbikes was an issue to you.

**What we are going to do:** Targeted patrols of hotspot locations as identified by local residents. If perpetrators are identified then appropriate action will be taken.

### Priority 3: Nuisance Motorbikes

**You Said:** Nuisance Motorbikes was an issue to you:

**What we are going to do:** The beat team will be monitoring reports of nuisance motorbikes throughout the Fosse Villages. When reports are received we will carry out enquires to identify perpetrators and take appropriate actions to disrupt them.

## You said we did

### Priority 1: Road Safety:

- Is the number one concern as raised by local residents in the area. At this time due to operational commitments and other priorities the beat team has been unable to conduct a speeding operation this month. When able we will do one in the near future if you have any specific concerns please get in touch and make us aware.

### Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

- This month now the schools are back in session we are seeing an increase in general anti-social behaviour in the local area . Please report any issues so we can deal with an identify any potential offenders as robustly as possible.

### Priority 3: Nuisance Motorbikes

- As of 04/09/24 There have been multiple reports of the use of nuisance motorbikes in an anti-social manner the beat team are monitoring and conducting patrols of known hotspot areas. When suspects are identified they will be dealt with appropriately. Should you have any concerns please let your beat team know.
